The restoration was part of a wider project to restore 5 different cultural sites around the world as part of the French Year 2000 Celebrations (Cuba, Mount Athos Greece, Cairo Egypt, Valletta France and Thailand).

In 2003, when King Maha Vajiralongkorn Bodindradebayavarangkun was officially crowned as the 10th king of the Chakri dynasty, we began the several palace's decoration project by his intention, most recently Vimanmek Royal Teak Mansion.

The workshop studio is located on the premises of the Jim Thompson Art Center, the clientele has grown considerably thanks to Thai collectors and many foreign collectors based in Bangkok, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Singapore, the United Stated and many other countries. The main

activities include textile, paper, wood objects, sculptures and historicalas well as contemporary-paintings restauration.
